

127th Fieracavalli scheduled in Verona 6-9 November

NEW LOOK FOR FIERACAVALLI: NEW SPACES, NEW STORIES - AND THE SAME PASSION

The 127th Fieracavalli in Verona 6-9 November features a redesigned layout better to meet the needs of visitors by ensuring an enhanced and functional experience thanks to upgraded facilities and a more contemporary re-organization of Show content: an impressive schedule of sporting competitions is joined by the best of breeders, an improved food offering and entertainment for the whole family.

Verona: 6-9 November 2025. Fieracavalli, the landmark international equestrian show, is revving up for edition number 127 – scheduled in Verona 6-9 November 2025. A completely upgraded **layout** will welcome more than 140.000 expected visitors comprising enthusiasts, riders and sector operators for an even more accessible and exciting show experience.

The new, more **fluid and intuitive** layout will guide visitors around 12 show halls and six outdoor areas at the Verona Exhibition Centre highlighting Italy's boo-diversity, the development of Italian saddle horses and the finest examples of Spanish and American breeds, on show thanks to 35 breeder associations, more than 2,200 horses travelling to Verona from all over the world, alongside more than 200 appointments embracing sporting competitions, performances and entertainment. The overall offering includes 700 exhibitors from 25 countries, turning Fieracavalli into the *place to be* for equestrian shopping for horses and riders alike.

Sport entertainment, as always, is a strong point of the event in Verona again this year, with an impressive show jumping program across two halls and four days. The **PALA RAM** (Show Hall 8) hosts the twenty-fourth **Jumping Verona** event, the only stage of the **Longines FEI Show Jumping World Cup™**, as well as the finals of the **Italian Champions Tour** and the **127x127 Fieracavalli Grand Prix**.

The **FISE ARENA** finds a new home in **Show Hall 11** boasting 7,900 sq.m. entirely dedicated to the competitions of the Italian Federation of Equestrian Sport, confirming once again the determination of the event in Verona to promote growth by upcoming generations.

And don't miss the chance to see the top national and international champions preparing for competition events in **Show Hall 7**, alongside the finest offering of accessories, clothing and technical products in the equestrian sector with **two rings** - warm-up and last-jump - specifically for the World Cup, as well as the practice field for the Italian Champions Tour: and the 127x127 Fieracavalli Grand Prix. In addition to sporting events, this year the Show Hall offers visitors the chance to witness an exceptional Dressage event, a discipline coming to Fieracavalli this year thanks to collaboration with the Stefano Ricci luxury lifestyle brand scheduled at 10:00-12:00 on Saturday 8 November: a clinic focusing on the "importance of the training method for a dressage horse in its various age bands" held by Edward Gal, an international champion known for his world records and successes in the saddle of Totilas. The offering in this Hall is completed by the debut of **Fieracavalli LAB**, the event space – developed in collaboration with Academy Partner **Croceri Farm**, together with **GBK Academy** and **Scuderia 1918** – hosting a busy schedule of talks, meet & greet events and appointments with riders, icons and celebrities in the equestrian world.

The **Western & Outdoor** area aims to explain and help the public at large experience the boundless beauty of the American prairies by turning **Show Hall 12** into the ideal venue for watching top riders competing in various Team Penning competitions, in addition to the special Reining event, with ten top reiners in the limelight on two unforgettable evenings. There will also be a warm welcome for the extraordinary appearance by **Pat Parelli**, the horse whisperer, returning to Verona after 15 years, thereby giving everyone the chance to watch exclusive demonstrations with the founder of the Parelli Natural Horsemanship programme, that today boasts 200,000 registered students in 73 countries. Lastly, visitors can discover all the features of Appaloosa, Paint and Quarter horses, in Show Hall 10. where AQHA (American Quarter Horse

Association) offers a superb program of morphology competitions, such as the All-Breed Challenge, the Grand Champion, the Most Colorful at Halter and Ranch Riding mount competitions.

And while the **Iberian Horse Show** in Hall 9 becomes even more evocative thanks to the installation designed by artisan artist HENRYTIMI and the performances of Doma Classica, Doma Vaquera, Alta Escuela and side-saddle riding mount, **Show Hall 3** hosts the finest display of **Thoroughbred Arabian Horses** taking part in international competitions such as the final of the Emirates Arabian Horse Global Cup and the Al Shira'aa Futurity Championship, the B International Show (ECAHO), the International Straight Egyptian Event and mounted competitions highlighting the versatility of this extraordinary breed.

A huge space will also focus specifically on Italian boo-diversity: Show Hall 10 – thanks to collaboration with **AIA-ITALIALLEVA, ANACAI TPR, ANACRHAI, and ANAM ANAREAI** – will allow visitors to admire 25 horse and 7 donkey breeds, for a total of 180 animals, taking turns in the traditional Italian Gala, the Presentation of Italian Breeds and the evocative Italian Carousel. There is also plenty of space for gentle training, thanks to the **Horse Friendly Arena** – the area dedicated to activities, training, and natural language interpretation led by Umberto Scotti – and twenty Parelli instructors ready to answer all the questions from audiences about this incredible method. **Show Hall 2**, under the aegis of **MASAF** (Ministry of Agriculture, Food Sovereignty and Forestry), is transformed into first horse racing event where visitors can not only experience the thrills of a day at the races - with the addition of a 200-meter track between Show Halls 2 and 4 - but also admire the finest Italian saddle horses, a true symbol of our regions, competing in the finals of the Breeding Circuit in Obedience and Gait, Morphology, and Free Jumping disciplines.

Fieracavalli is not only sport but also discovery and education. The **Future Riders Show** (Hall 1) is specifically dedicated to children, offering play & educational workshops and entertainment designed to lead children and families into the world of horses and donkeys, the other half of the equestrian world. **Outside Area A** has a large covered ring hosting shows and demos throughout the day to showcase horses as work companions, artistic protagonists and precious support for physical and emotional well-being. Healthcare & Leisure is another new event this year (Show Hall 4) where experiential workshops and interactive activities will help visitors discover the therapeutic, educational and social value of interaction with horses, thanks to the involvement of entities such as HOLtre, Fieracavalli USA HorseMan Academy, ASD Horse Valley and Il Colle per le Famiglie.

This approach to knowledge of the equestrian world also includes **Horse Future Lab – Arts & Crafts**, a project dedicating two days to the world of schools and training with the aim of allowing young people to imagine new career paths through orientation sessions, meetings with companies, and workshops.

Furthermore, the 127th Fieracavalli has re-designed its **food area**, turning it into an integral part of the content made available to visitors, thanks to its food guru curator **Filippo Polidori**. Audiences will not only be able to discover the world of horses from every angle but also enjoy Italian hospitality.

Lastly, nor should you miss the appointment with "**Bellezza**", the evening **Gold Gala** in Show Hall 8 with leading national and international equestrian artists bound to ensure an exciting atmosphere.
