

127th edition of the event scheduled at Veronafiere 6-9 November

NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL EQUINE BIODIVERSITY IN THE FOREFRONT AT FIERACAVALLI

Verona, 6- November 2025. 2,200 horses, 60 breeds and a single event: Fieracavalli. The Veronafiere Exhibition Center will be transformed 6-9 November into a venue where more than 140,000 enthusiasts and the merely curious can take a journey of discovery with the world's most fascinating horse breeds. Four show halls and outdoor area A will host competitions, exhibitions and events embracing equine breeding and biodiversity - thanks to the involvement of 35 associations: these shows will take visitors across continents, cultures, and traditions, thereby confirming the Verona event as the most important on the international equestrian scene.

The journey begins in the **Arabian Horse Show Hall** - in collaboration with *Arabian Horse Magazine* - where 150 Arabian thoroughbreds will highlight the essence of one of the world's oldest breeds through morphology competitions and major international events such as the final of the **Emirates Arabian Horse Global Cup** world tour and the **Al Shira'aa Futurity Championship**, joined by the **B International Show (ECAHO)**, the **International Straight Egyptian Event** and the evocative **Liberty Class**, celebrating the authentic bond between horses and handlers.

It is only a short step from Arabia to the Iberian Peninsula. Show Hall 9 is home to **Equitación Ibérica Italia** spotlighting the fascination of **Pura Raza Española**, with more than 160 horses taking part in the **Coppa Italia di Addestramento Classico**, the **3rd Coppa dei Maestri di Doma Vaquera**, the **Arte ed Eleganza** competition organized by *Fitetrec-Ante* and the **Iberian Show** - not to mention demos of Alta Escuela, Doma Classica, Doma Vaquera, side-saddle riding and a classic training master class with Andrea Giovannini. All the more, the 127th edition sees a facelift for the **Iberian Horse Show** by inaugurating a new approach to promotion thanks to the artistic direction of designer **HENRYTIMI**, transforming the venue into a setting with a strong visual impact, where minimalism and natural materials enhance the tradition and elegance of this breed.

A few short steps take us from Iberian charm to the beating heart of European biodiversity: **Italy**.

Ring A in Show Hall 10 - thanks to collaboration with **AIA-ITALIALLEVA**, **ANACAITPR**, **ANACRHAI**, **ANAM** and **ANAREAI** - will welcome 25 horse and 7 donkey breeds – for a total of 180 animals – taking turns in the traditional **Italian Gala**, the **Presentation of Italian Breeds** and numerous events covering to morphology, insights and entertainment, with the evocative **Italian Carousel**.

Italian Saddle Horses are a true excellence of our territory and the main attraction in Show Hall 2, where – in collaboration with **MASAF (Ministry of Agriculture, Food Sovereignty and Forestry)** – the finest examples compete for the **final of the Breeding Circuit**, in disciplines covering **Obedience and Gaits**, **Morphology** and **Free Jumping**, in a huge celebration of the quality and richness of Italian equine biodiversity.

From Italy we fly across the ocean directly to America in Ring B, Show Hall 10, where the **Italian Quarter Horse Association (AIQH)** explains the soul of the western world through **Halter** competitions. **Quarter**, **Appaloosa** and **Paint** horses enter the ring, accompanied by their handlers, to be judged for their balance, build and musculature in tests that highlight the typical features of each breed. Traditional classes are now also joined by others specifically for the colour of the coat – such as the **Most Colorful at Halter** for Appaloosa horses and the **Colored Classes** for the Paint breed – together with **Best in Show** and the historical **Grand Champion**. Foals make their debut in the **All-Breed Challenge**, while **Ranch Riding** tells the story of the versatility of typical US breeds, with courses inspired by work on American farms, where precision and harmony are sought over speed.

The world tour of horse breeds comes to an end in **Area A**, where the grandeur of **Shire horses**, the grace of **Frisians** and the versatility of **Quarabs** provide the final stage of this itinerary that brings different worlds and cultures together through a single passion: passion for horses.

The appointment with the finest national and international breeders is at **Fieracavalli** in **Verona 6-9 November**.
